Purpose of the Report

The purpose of this report is to assist a building owner and/or occupier in Queensland, Australia to meet its obligations under the Queensland Building Fire Safety Regulations 2008.

Owners or occupiers of a class 2-9 building in Queensland, have an obligation to ensure the safety of any person in your building in the event of a fire or hazardous material emergency.

This report is designed to assist those owners and occupiers to manage their legislative obligations under the Queensland Building Fire Safety Regulations 2008.

Fire Safety Adviser

With reference to the Building Fire Safety Regulation 2008, section 34, it is required that the owner / occupier of Example Building appoint a qualified fire safety adviser (FSA) to the building. (Class 2 or 3 building over 25m in effective height).

According to the above legislation, the role of the FSA is to conduct worker first response training and evacuation coordination training.

In addition, Star BMS may assist with the development of a fire evacuation plan and to provide general fire safety advice.

Currently, Star BMS is appointed as the FSA to your building.

<u>Assessment</u>

An assessment was made of the status of your building in relation to the Queensland Building Fire Safety Regulations 2008. The FSA has assessed the following key areas:

- Fire and evacuation planning
- Evacuation signage
- Evacuation and first response training and evacuation practice
- Fire safety installation maintenance
- Record keeping
- Evacuation escape routes

Areas that require attention and/or action are stated.

Fire Compliance Documents	Compliant		Example Building management has a fire safety compliance folder that contains all of the required documents (excepting testing log books). Copies of these documents are also kept off site with Star BMS.	It is required that the body corporate keeps fire compliance records on site in a place safe from the effects of fire, as well as off site. This may be in an electronic form. Ref: Building Fire Safety Regulation 2008, section 71, 72 and 86
Certificate of Classification	Compliant			It is required that the body corporate obtains and displays a certificate of classification for the building. This document can be sourced from council. Ref: Building Fire Safety Regulation 2008, section 25 and Building Act 1975 – Section 108A
Fire exit paths checked	Compliant		Example Building management and the residents of the building are required to ensure that all fire exit paths and exit areas are kept clear at all times.	It is required that the body corporate ensures that the evacuation routes are clear of obstructions at all times. The evacuation route must be a minimum of one metre wide. Final exits must be clear of obstructions within 2 metres. Ref: Building Fire Safety Regulation 2008, section 8

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
